The Bunker Studio

The Bunker is our largest studio space. Centred around an Audient ASP8024 Heritage Edition large format recording console, this HDX-enabled space provides high acoustic specification with mastering grade PCM monitoring and 5.1 mixing with a dedicated monitor controller. And the obligatory NS10s. The digital heart of the studio is a Mac Pro and there is a completely sound proofed live room so we can make as much noise as we like 24 hours a day without disturbing the neighbours. As well as the main live space there is a built-in vocal booth and a green room/chill out space that is cabled in to act as a 4th recording space should the session demand it.



The Bunker control room is well equipped with high end, classic outboard units, and cutting-edge digital controller instruments.
